



CNCR PERMISSION TO TEST FORM AT A COMPETITION

TEST AT COMPETITIONS ARE SUBJECT TO THE AVAILABILITY OF JUDGES AND ICE TIME. THE ONLY TESTS THAT WILL BE ALLOWED AT A COMPETITION ARE HIGH FREESKATE AND INTERPRETIVES.

- Skaters must enter into the event that corresponds with the test taken. You must have the correct music length for the test you are trying. You will be tested while you are competing.
- Applications for tests must be returned by the Competition deadline. **NO EXCEPTIONS**
- Only after the Competition schedule has been finalized and the judges are in place, will your club be notified if your application for tests will be accommodated.
- After notification, **CORRECTLY COMPLETED TEST PAPERS, SUMMARY SHEETS, AND SKATE CANADA TEST FEES** must be brought to the competition and personally handed to the Host Club's Test Chairperson prior to the testing. Failure to do so will result in the test being disallowed.
- If test have to be scheduled prior to or after the competition, costs may be billed between the testing skaters.
